Forest Ridge is licensed by the State of Wisconsin as a Residential Care Apartment Complex (RCAC). We follow guidance provided by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services, which includes response to the COVID-19 Pandemic. We also partner with the Hales Corners Public Health Department in all matters related to the pandemic.

As of September, we offer limited guest visits with reservations, Monday through Friday until 6pm, and other times under special circumstances. All visitors are screened upon arriving for their reserved time.

Forest Ridge offers in-house activities for our residents, including social get togethers, games, discussion groups, a book club, exercise classes, movies, and more! All activities are conducted with increased sanitation of activity locations, including the use of air purifiers, pre-and-post activity cleaning of surfaces, and screening of all participants. Residents sign-up for activities as participation is limited, but most activities are repeated so all who wish can attend.

Both our Protestant and Catholic worship services have resumed, as has daily Rosary. We also have opened our dining room at lunch time for a limited number of diners Monday through Friday to enjoy a meal with others.

Our salon has re-opened, much to the delight of residents, and their beloved Bingo is again offered a few times each week.

All activities have participation limits and extra steps to maintain a safe environment for all continue.

Residents, staff, guests and vendors are required to wear a mask, and reminders to practice social distancing, wash hands, and avoid risks are displayed throughout our community.
