



Forest Ridge is licensed by the State of Wisconsin as a Residential Care Apartment Complex (RCAC). We follow guidance provided by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services, which includes response to the COVID-19 Pandemic. We also partner with the Hales Corners Public Health Department in all matters related to the pandemic.

Currently (December 2020) in-house activities involving large groups of residents remain suspended. Special activities are planned for residents which do not involve close or sustained contact with others. These offerings are communicated to residents in our monthly newsletter, weekly reminders, and monthly activity calendar.

Pre-approved medically necessary visits continue. We recently notified residents that requests for compassionate care visits also may be made, either by the resident or family member/loved one. These visits support the emotional wellbeing of residents struggling with ongoing isolation. In addition, we provide virtual visits to residents, to have "face-time" with their loved ones as well as friendly phone calls made by their neighbors.

As an RCAC, Forest Ridge is considered a long-term care provider and therefore will receive the COVID-19 vaccination within the higher priority tier. Although no confirmed date of the availability of the vaccine to our residents has been determined, we anticipate this will occur sometime in the latter part of January. Communication to our residents will be provided with the process for receiving the on-site vaccinations.
